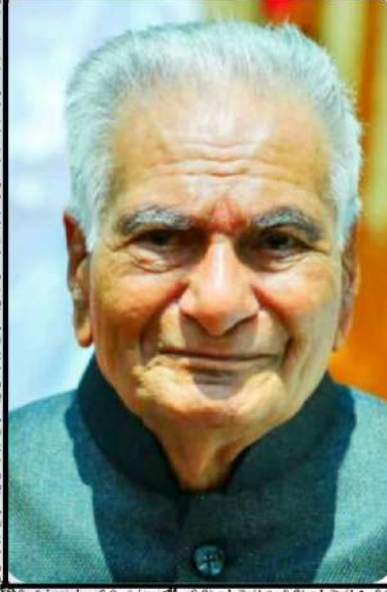

THE MISSIONARY LEGEND : SHRI THAKORBHAI N. DESAI

"A leader is one who sees more than others see, who sees farther than others see, and who sees before others see." — LeRoy Eims

Such was Shri Thakorbhai N. Desai, our loving Dadaji. A visionary, a self-reliant and a proactive teacher-leader, a trailblazer who set his passionate world of education on fire with his authentic ideas, deeds and geniuses. A man of great thoughts who inspired people to believe in themselves is a legend, an eminent Guru and an institution in himself.

Shri Desai was born and brought up in a small village called "Umarsadi" in the district of Valsad, Gujarat. He came to Mumbai for higher studies after completing his basic education in Valsad. After completing his education and possessing an excellent academic record he started his career as an Assistant Teacher. This was just the beginning of his legendary life. Shri. Desai always had a heart for deprived children. His concern for diligent but poor students was seen to the extent that he had even rented a temple top floor to teach them for free. Dadaji served on various designations and then retired as the principal from Devchand Jethalal High School, Malad (E). During his service tenure he had been a part of various government delegations visiting foreign countries to learn and enhance the development of educational facilities in Maharashtra. His eminent contribution to the field of education was rewarded with the Best Teacher award in 1986 from the Government of Maharashtra.

Shri T.N. Desai is the founder of Nirmala Memorial Foundation. This Trust was formed in the fond memory of his beloved wife Late Smt. Nirmala Desai with the purpose of providing quality education to the downtrodden, poor and needy children. Under his Chairmanship, Nirmala Memorial Foundation made its humble beginning with a Gujarati medium school in the slum pockets of Khot Dongri at Malad East and within a short span of time the school gained glory by achieving 100% results for consecutive years in SSC Examinations.

Dadaji dreamt, desired and strived to see the banner of Nirmala Memorial Foundation among the premier educational institutions in the Mumbai suburbs.

In 1999, the NMF Junior College started and became the first institute in Mumbai to have a direct association with IMC schools. It meant that the college which was started in three rooms of Rani Sati Marg Municipal School building in Malad offered the same education, quality and experience in Commerce stream that too without any astronomical fees. Today there are several institutes under the banner of Nirmala Memorial Foundation all around Mumbai suburbs offering prestigious traditional and professional courses to thousands of students.

Dadaji remained active throughout his life even when the lockdown was inflicted. He ensured to visit NMF Junior College, Malad at least twice a week himself as his love and passion for education and students were immense.

Dadaji had been the primum mobile or the first-mover, who created the template on how to dare and set the direction to follow his divine aim of serving humanity through education. He led an exemplary life. His life and legacy will always shine bright spreading message to the world that-

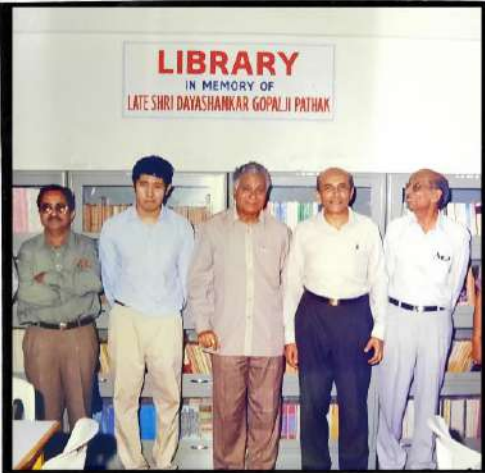

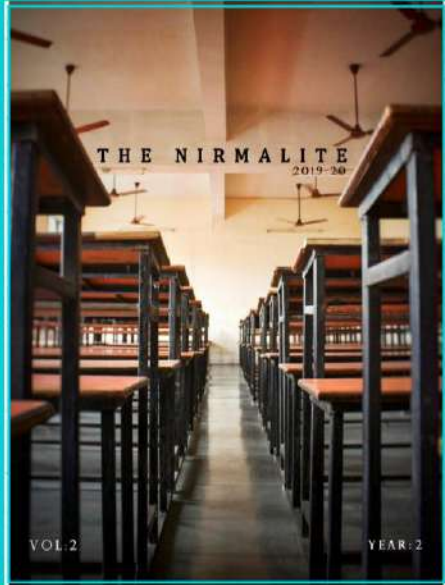

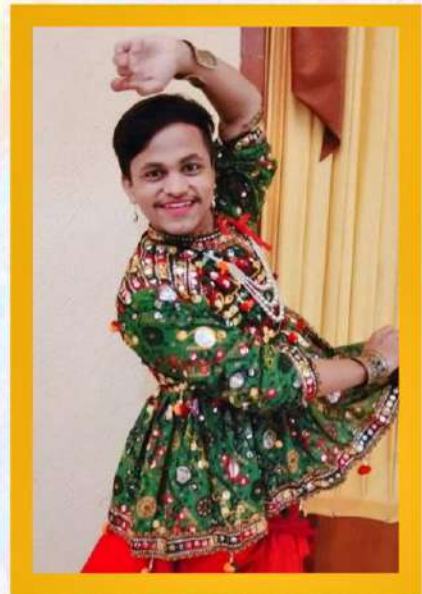


Mr. Kunal Urmila Ulhas Naik, FYBAMMC

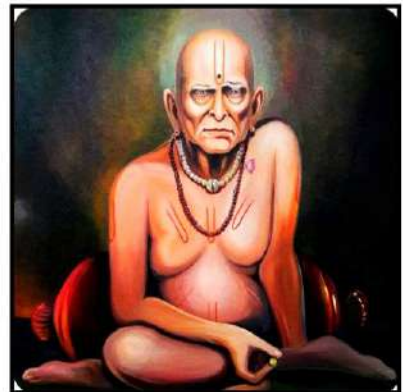

Parents Teachers Meeting

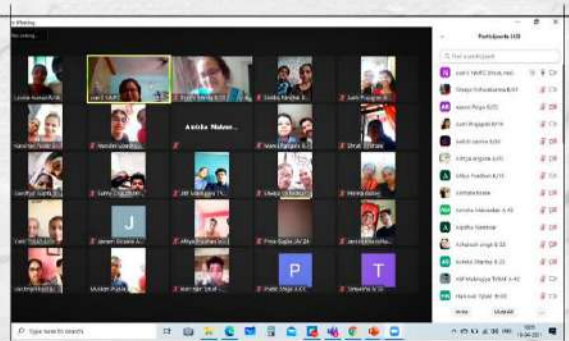
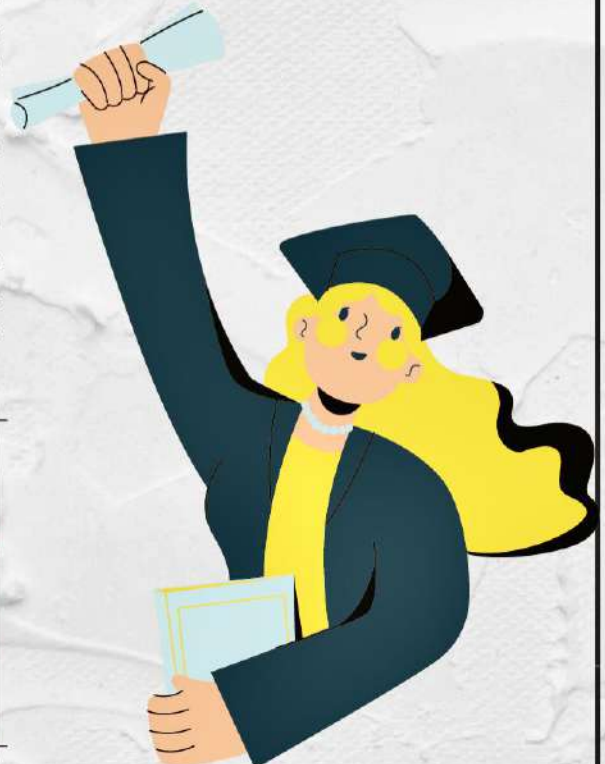
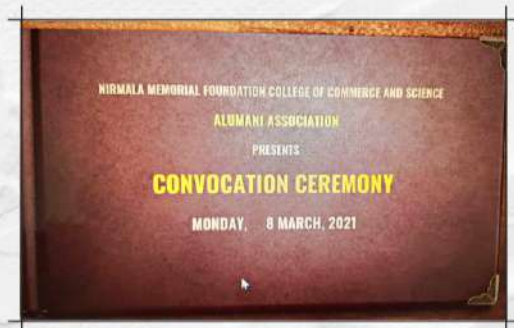

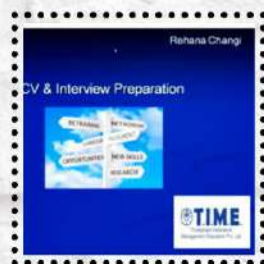
Write up on the Workshop by Garware Institute of Career Education and Development

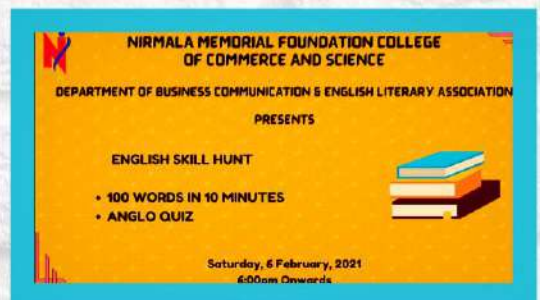

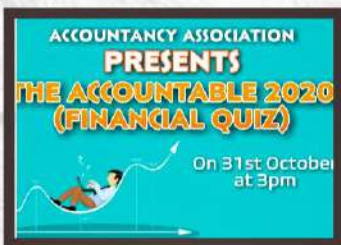

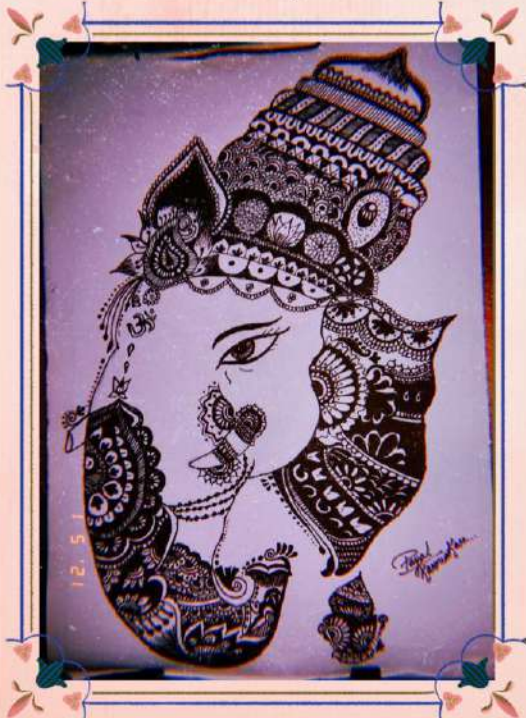
